THE BISHOP'S CORNER

Dear Fellow-Catholics,

On the 1st of January the Saudi Foreign Ministry stated that a man from Pakistan was sentenced to death and executed for heroin smuggling in Saudi Arabia. This was how 2019 began in Saudi Arabia.

According to official statistics there were 125 executions in 2018, 122 executions in 2017 and a 144 in 2016 in Saudi Arabia. The most common method is beheading, although sometimes shooting is used.

Saudi Arabia is one of the 55 countries that maintain the death penalty and is at the forefront of those where it is most often carried out.

Death sentences are also carried out in China (over 1500 a year), Iran (over 500) and in Iraq (over 120, but there are no full statistics). It is also possible that this happens in several other countries such as North Korea, but the information is not normally disclosed.

May God inspire all humans, regardless of ones beliefs, to respect every life even the difficult or troubled ones.

VOLUNTEERS SOUGHT FOR THE SOUP RUN PROGRAM

For a number of years the Diocese has been assisting the Salvation Army with its outreach program of providing food to the homeless in the city of Hamilton and surrounding areas – otherwise known as the Soup Run. The Diocese helps on Monday, Tuesday and Saturday evenings between the hours of 5pm and 7pm. Volunteers meet at Harbour Lights (the Salvation Army's premises at the junction of Victoria and King streets) at 5pm to make up sandwiches and then distribute the sandwiches and soup around Hamilton and surrounding areas. Volunteers work in teams of four and operate in a roster whereby each team is normally "on" once every four weeks. We are looking for new volunteers to help with this worthwhile and rewarding program. Supplies are provided and so the only "outlay" for volunteers is the actual time commitment.
