THE BISHOP'S CORNER

My Dear Fellow-Catholics

It has been a while (around two years) that I have been wrestling with a dream. I've approached it several times with a desire to move forward but there is always something stopping me. I don't want the dream to become a nightmare, so I believe it is time for action.

My dream is to have a Diocesan Family Festival in a space like the Botanical Gardens where we can spend a Saturday together and invite other people to join us in our celebration. There would be space for fun and games, food corners, entertainment (music & dances) and many other ways of celebrating as a community.

It could also be a good fund-raiser for a particular goal, i.e. a Summer Youth Conference perhaps.

This event should take place close to the anniversary of the foundation of our Diocese in 2019, keeping in mind the other important feasts and events around that time. There are two Saturdays available from my perspective: 18th May 2019 or 15th June 2019. The time of the event would be from 9:00am to 5:00pm.

There is currently a small group of good people who support this idea and are assisting with many details concerning the organization of this festival. Right now I am at the point of preparing a letter to the Botanical Garden Administration to book the place. It is a critical point because once this booking is done; there will be no turning back.

Before I send in this request to the Government Parks Department, I must know a few things: Do you, my People, think that this idea has merit and is worthy of spending the time and the resources to organize? Are you interested in it? Would you be able to volunteer your time to assist in organizing and leading some of the facets for the event? I am aware that you are busy with many things, but I would need your help in making this work. We would need approximately 50 volunteers to serve during the festival if we want to do something really big. Without a solid group of committed people there is no sense in moving forward with the idea.

Peace and Social Justice Ministry - The Peace and Social Justice Ministry of the Roman Catholic Church will be hosting a series of **One Day Workshops** for our adult church community (those 18 years and older) to raise awareness on racism, racial

injustice and our call as a church community to solidarity, in doing something to help heal these injustices.

These workshops are a part of a larger anti-racism summit which will culminate with international speakers, experts on this topic, who will join us in November to further expound upon how we as Christians can address and help heal, by taking a progressive stand to address this delicate issue.

The workshops will be held in EACH church parish – preferably on a Saturday from about 9:30am-2:00pm - with a lunch break in between. We ask that you support our whole church community in this initiative and sign up to attend your parish workshop on the date specified.

CCD

1. May is the month for registration of children to the CCD program for September 2018. Youth must be in their 5th year to enter Kindergarten. Children born in the year of 2013. Families should be registered in your parish (that means we should be able to find them in the database system) or must attach a Parish registration form to the CCD application. Please remember that overseas baptisms require a copy of the baptism certificate to be attached to the CCD registration form.

2. CCD fees of \$140 per child is due during the month of May. Make payments on line, cash or check to the Parish. Please post direct banking instructions if your parish receives fees for students continuing their studies.

3. Please talk with your PCL regarding if new catechists are needed. Prior to having a class registered in your parish you must have a catechist in place. Your PCL will now know who will be returning in the fall and which classes they will need new catechists for.

Flores de Mayo and Santacruzán Festival - We are pleased to invite everyone to witness and join the Filipino community in Bermuda on **May 27th**, from **1:15pm to 4:30pm** as we celebrate **Flores de Mayo and Santacruzán Festival** – a beautiful Filipino traditions commemorating “May Flower” in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the commemoration of finding of St. Helena (Empress Helena) of the True Holy Cross where Jesus Christ was crucified.

The festival will start at 1:15pm at St. Theresa's Cathedral with a short introduction of the festival, and a recitation of the Holy Rosary in 5 languages (English, Tagalog, Visaya, Portuguese and Hindi). A short procession will follow, consisting of the clergy, the congregation and a parade of beautiful women (“Sagalas” or “Reynas”), representing a number of Marian Titles as well as remarkable women heroes of the Bible. Upon coming back from the procession, people will then pay homage to the Blessed Mother's statue by offering flowers, followed by a roll call of the Sagalas/Reynas. After the final blessing, refreshments will then be served at the hall. Please bring a flower with you during the day to offer to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This event is organized by Couples for Christ and Family Ministries Bermuda, in collaboration with the Association of Filipinos in Bermuda, Club 2000, Filipino Sports Group, and the Parishes of the Diocese of Hamilton Bermuda. Come and join us in celebrating this colorful Marian tradition!
